The Expression of our Hope

1 Peter 1:13-25

The Point: Our hope in Christ changes how we view the world and live in it.

I. Live in Grace and Holiness instead of conformity to the world...vv. 13-16

- Ready your minds for action and be sober-minded.
- Set your hope completely on the grace of Jesus Christ.
- Do not conform to the "old" desires Be obedient!
- Be Holy in all your conduct.
- Holy = Set apart.

Some Lasting Truths in 1 Peter 1:13-16

- Our mindset as Christians should be focused on the hope that we have in Jesus Christ.
- Holiness is made possible for us because of the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ.
- Since God is holy and we are His children, we are called to be holy.
- Holy living is vital to our witness as followers of Jesus.

II. Live as God's people because we have been redeemed...vv. 17-21

- Conduct yourselves in reverence.
- We are strangers and should live like it.
- Our works and conduct will be judged one day.

- We were redeemed not with perishable things but with the blood of Jesus Christ.
- We can place our faith and hope in Christ because he has done everything necessary for us to have peace with God.

Some Lasting Truths in 1 Peter 1:17-21

- Knowledge of a certain future judgment is plenty of motivation for us to live a holy life on earth right now.
- We have been redeemed by the precious blood of Jesus Christ.
- Because Jesus has paid the price for our redemption, we can place our hope and trust in Him.

III. Following God's Word helps us remain pure...vv. 22-25

- We are purified by obeying the truth through the Holy Spirit.
- Sincere love for one another is proof of purity.
- We are to love one another because we have been born again.
- God's Word endures forever and has the power to change lives.

Some Lasting Truths in 1 Peter 1:22-25

- God's Word has a sanctifying effect on those who put it into practice.
- The presence of God's love in our hearts is confirmation of our experience of the new birth in Christ.
- The seed of God's Word produces life and fruit in our lives for all to see.
- Unlike man's words, God's Word has dynamic power to change our lives.
