We still need to finish our handicap parking spots to get full occupancy which we are planning to do this Friday weather permitting.

We have had three new families coming this last month which has been exciting. We have two baptisms coming up, and we are trying to get our baptistry in as quickly as possible.

project through their local home churches. We have had help from our sister churches from across the nation, and our own association of churches has given a large amount to the project as well.

It has taken a while to come to this point, but we have accomplished every phase debt free and are still planning to continue this way. We are currently working on the parking lot and the exterior sidewalks. Though we are in the building there is much to be done, and we could still use help to accomplish this. The concrete work for our handicap parking spots and side walks will cost approximately \$8,000 with all the labour being done by volunteers.

Finally, my goal always has been to plant a church in Rouzerville that will be able to support itself and a pastor full time. As for now I am still in need of support which I pray will soon be turned over to the local church as their responsibility.
