OUT OF SIGHT, OUT OF MIND

It never ceases to amaze me how quickly people forget. In February 2022, Russia invaded Ukraine in an escalation of the Russian-Ukrainian conflict that began in 2014. The invasion was the most significant attack on a European country since World War II. The war was in the news media 24/7 for months, and now, 18 months later, you rarely hear anything about it. People soon forget because they are not there; they no longer hear much about what is happening, "out of sight, out of mind." We have not forgotten. We have seen the devastation, the hopelessness and fear, the suffering and even death. Because we have been there and continue to go back, we are moved to action by what we see and experience. Unless one experiences the needs and sufferings of others, it becomes nearly impossible to relate to them. Jesus expressed it best when He said, "... behold, I say unto you, Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest." (John 4:35). Phase Two Update



After nine weeks, our ten appointees finished their classroom instruction and are now doing their rural practicum in a village. These couples and families have shown true commitment to their call to missions; we are so proud of them. At this point, they have completed language and culture acquisition, crisis planning and situational awareness, church planting, and worldviews; each team had to create a five-year church planting plan based on components they learned from all their courses.

After classroom completion on Ministry in a Muslim Context, each of them go to live for eight days with an Albanian Muslim family where they will apply much of what they learned. To best prepare our workers for cross-cultural service, it is necessary for us to take them out of their familiar living and ministry contexts and expose them closer to what they will be experiencing on the field. Over the years, this has proven invaluable for their cultural understanding and long-term effectiveness as church planters
