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1. During August, we held two outdoor gatherings featuring Bible picture-story shows. The stories were about Jesus' crucifixion and His resurrection. Two families with non-believing parents and children attended. Passersby nearby also watched from a distance. We pray that the seeds of the Gospel will sprout and bear fruit.



2. On the afternoon of Sunday, August 10th, we held the Summer Sunday School Fun Day (or VBS). We also notified neighbors, reaching out to non-believers. During worship, we learned about the Creation of Heaven and Earth, offering praise and prayer. The children enjoyed super ball scooping, games, and shaved ice. It was also good that Brother Yoshihara volunteered in this event for the first time.



4. The JBA Adult Camp was held in grace from August 11th to 13th, with five campers from our church participating. Under the theme of The succession of faith, we thoroughly studied from the Bible about church succession, family evangelism, social evangelism, and various issues of The succession of faith. Group discussions, time to hear testimonies from seven individuals, pastors' fellowship and auxiliaries, and fellowship during free time were all very blessed. While non-believers did not participate, it seems many

believers experienced revival.

5. On Sunday, August 17th, Minori Yoshihara, a classmate and friend of Sister Miki Kamoda, attended both Sunday School and the morning worship service for the first time. Her brother, Brother Yoshihara, is a believer who attends worship every week, and she has also become interested in the Bible. Her attendance is still irregular, but my wife answered her questions and shared her testimony after the service, so we have hope for her salvation in the future. Please pray for her.

6. The JBA Sunday School Camp was held in grace from August 18-20, with six campers from our church participating. We studied the Word centered on the theme of the Beatitudes from the Sermon on the Mount. As usual, the camp was filled with rich learning, crafts, and recreation. Children who are not believers also attended, and several children expressed their decision to trust in Jesus as Lord. It seems some also expressed a desire for baptism. Sister Mayu Shiraishi, a member of our church, was honored for attending Sunday School Camp every year without fail from first grade through her senior year of high school.



7. On Sunday, August 24th, we held our church's youth fellowship meeting. Though only six people attended, the content was rich and blessed. After worship, we cooked and ate large hamburger dinner together, enjoying conversation. Finally, we enjoyed fireworks at the park. It was good to deepen fellowship among the young believers.
