1. Although outdoor gatherings were suspended in September, our church distributed 5,000 meeting flyers containing Bible verses and messages throughout Hachioji City and neighboring Tama City in preparation





for the special evangelistic services. We focused heavily on direct distribution, handing flyers to people at their doorsteps and on the streets while introducing our church. We encouraged church members to personally invite their family and friends. We pray that the seeds of the Gospel will sprout and bear fruit.

2. Sunday School, worship services, prayer meetings, and Bible study classes were held as usual each week.





In observance of Respect for the Aged Day, a Japanese national holiday, we held a special worship service to honor and express gratitude to our elders. Work was done to replace the blinds in the church building which cost \$800.
